Applications on the prescribed format are invited from eligible students of IUST for submitting their candidatures to avail Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) Scheme. The Scheme is offered to meritorious students who belong to economically weaker sections. The students who were enrolled at IUST in the year 2016 in the following programmes can **only** apply:

1. *B.Tech. Civil Engineering.*
2. *B.Tech. Computer Science & Engineering.*
3. *M.Sc. Chemistry.*
4. *M.Sc. Food Technology.*
5. *M.Sc. Physics.*
6. *M.Sc. Statistics.*
7. *Master of Business Administration in International Business (MBA-IB).*
8. *Master of Computer Science (MCA).*

The Application Form can be downloaded from University website www.iustlive.com. The hard copies of the Application Forms duly filled in should reach to office of the undersigned along with all the pre-requisite documents by or before 3rd of April, 2017 (Monday).

Documents to be attached with the Application Form:

- Permanent Resident Certificate.
- Income certificate (issued by the concerned Tehsildar) in original (*strictly as per university format*).

Conditions for Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme:

- a) The candidates whose parental annual income is less than Rs. 4.50 lakhs from all sources shall only be eligible to apply under this scheme. In this regard, a certificate from concerned Tehsildar as per the prescribed format need to be produced at the time of submission of this Application Form.
- b) The waiver is limited to the tuition fee only. All other fee except tuition fee shall have to be paid by the selected beneficiary.
- c) In the event of non-availability of students in this category the same shall not be allotted to any other category of applicants.
- d) Only one candidate from a particular family shall be eligible to avail the benefit of Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme.
- e) The scheme is **NOT** applicable to candidates admitted under **Self Financing** category and **NRI quota**.
- f) TFWS will be applicable subject to fulfilment of approved/sanctioned seats in each course/programme.
- g) The selection under TFW scheme shall be based on the total merit of the student obtained at the time of his/her admission and income specified above.
- h) Students admitted under this scheme shall not be allowed to change Institution/Course/Branch under any circumstances.
- i) Students admitted under TFW scheme have to produce an affidavit from 1st Class Magistrate to the effect that he/she is not availing any other scholarship. If found otherwise his/her candidature shall be cancelled under TFW scheme for the year 2016-17.
